## **CITY OF LANGLEY NOTICE OF ACTION UNDER SEPA**

Notice is given under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), RCW 43.21C.080, that the City of Langley, in accordance with WAC 197-11-340, did on April 20, 2016 issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for a proposal by Nichols Brothers Boat Builders for placement and use of a permanent anchoring system comprised of four (4) vessel anchors with a 90-foot long segment of chain and a locator buoy attached to each anchor. The anchor system will provide moorage for large vessels during repair, refurbishment, and outfitting as part of normal operations.

This project is located in Saratoga Passage near shore adjacent to the City of Langley approximately 500 feet from the shoreline and 300 feet of the existing dock.

The City of Langley, as lead agency for this proposal, has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and that an environmental impact statement (EIS) is therefore not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). The decision to issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. The complete file of the proposal, including the environmental determination, is available for review at Langley City Hall, 112 Second Street, Langley, during normal business hours.

Because the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife also has jurisdiction in this proposed action, the City of Langley, in accordance with WAC 197-11-340(2) will not therefore act upon the proposal for 14 days from April 20, 2016. Comments may be submitted to the above address. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review or otherwise challenge such action after May 5, 2016 on the grounds of noncompliance with the provisions of 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before May 19, 2016.
