

**CITY OF LANGLEY  
NOTICE OF ACTION**

Notice is given under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), RCW 43.21C.080, that the City of Langley, in accordance with WAC 197-11-340, did on September 18, 2015 issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for a proposal by Rich Frishman and Brenda Hartman to replace a failed septic system at 832 – 834 Saratoga Road in the City of Langley. This project is located within 200 feet of a critical area, as identified on the Critical Areas Map for the City of Langley.

The City of Langley, as lead agency for this proposal, has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and that an environmental impact statement (EIS) is therefore not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). The decision to issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. The complete file of the proposal, including the environmental determination, is available for review at Langley City Hall, 112 Second Street, Langley, during normal business hours.

The City of Langley will accept comments on this application for thirty (30) days from the date of this Determination of Non-Significance. Comments may be submitted to the above address.
