A Message from Commissioner Johnson:

Community Impact Grants Available to Nonprofits and Public Agencies

The Island County Board of Commissioners are releasing an additional \$400,000.00 of the federal CARES grant funds. These funds will target organizations that are experiencing additional and unique demands that are brought on by Covid-19. The funds will be available to non-profit and public programs that help sustain and support both economic programming and programs for those in need and have demonstrated a regional or county-wide impact.

This is grant funding that is not required to be repaid, but must show significant community impact to be received.

Ranking Criteria:

- Positive benefit to our community- both economically or through social service programming
- Wide regional impacts with priority going to organization that provide services county-wide
- Clear impacts, programming needs or increase in demand caused by COVID-19
