



Formation of a Tourist Funding Review Ad Hoc Committee

The Langley City Council has decided to form an ad hoc committee (working group) to help evaluate and rank the requests for Tourism funding. The monies to be applied come from the State's Tourism Tax program. As the level of tourism has increased in Langley, and as this funding is on a percentage basis, the amount to be allocated has also risen. . Similarly, the numbers of requests for funding have risen as well.

This ad hoc committee when formed will only need to meet before the annual City budget period and as unbudgeted requests arise during the year.

It will be a small group with Councilpersons Dominique Emerson and Bruce Allen as the Council representatives. They are looking for a representative from the restaurant sector and one from the accommodation sector to join the working group.

This group will review the current application form and develop a ranking system. Subsequently, the workgroup will be ranking the funding requests and advising the full City Council who will make the final allocation decisions.
