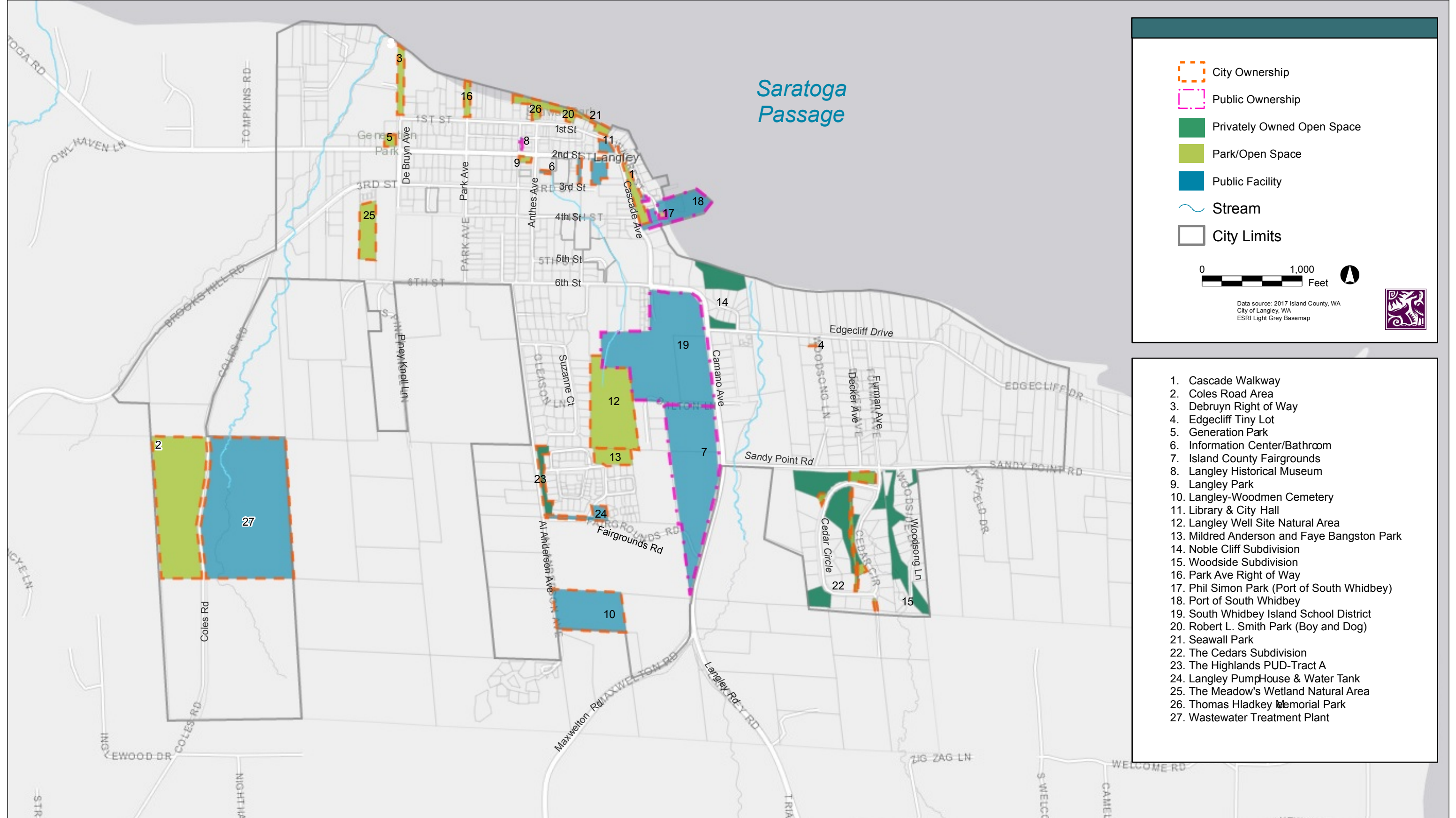


Figure POS-2 Langley Parks and Open Space
