## Proclamation of Local Emergency In Langley, WA.

**Whereas**, the Island County Emergency Management Department has declared a state of emergency in response to the COVID-19 virus; and

**Whereas**, the City of Langley in response to the Island County declaration is now required to enact its supporting emergency plans; and

**Whereas**, the COVID-19 virus creates a condition of extreme peril to the safety of persons within the City; and

**Whereas**, all available resources are committed to response to the possible epidemic; and

**Whereas**, the City requires supplemental assistance; and

**Whereas**; the severity and scope of this epidemic is predicted to be beyond the capabilities of local resources; and

**Whereas**; the conditions warrant the proclamation of the existence of a **LOCAL EMERGENCY**;

**Therefore**, I, Tim Callison, Mayor of Langley, Washington, do hereby proclaim that a **LOCAL EMERGENCY** now exists due to the COVID-19 virus and that Emergency Operations are in effect, and this necessitates the utilization of emergency powers granted under RCW 38.52.070 and LMC Chapter 4.01.
